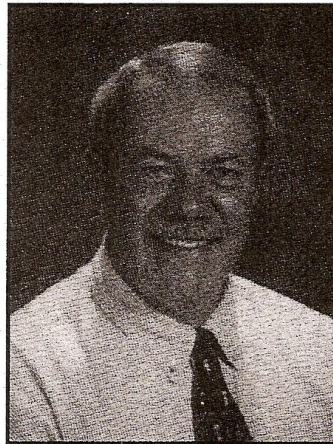


The Dan Mullett Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the Columbia City Community's gifts to the memory of Dan L. Mullett, educator and principal in the Whitley County School System until his untimely death on July 24, 2001.

The essence of Dan Mullett was his unwavering, unconditional love for children. He was an advocate for the young students who passed through his schools, believing in them when no one else would. At the time of his passing, a rewording of a familiar quote came to characterize his life:

One hundred years from now it won't matter that I drove a rusted truck or wore deer shirts. What will be remembered is that I was important in the life of a child.

This scholarship is available to a Columbia City High School senior, in the top half of their class. The applicant should be seeking a four-year baccalaureate degree in elementary education. Above all, the applicant should mirror the unrelenting love for children that characterized the life of Dan Mullett.
